Reminder – Family Doctor registration, Medicare Card renewal kiosk on <u>Wednesday</u>

(Kahnawake – 26, Enníska/February 2024) Tehsakotitsén:tha Kateri Memorial Hospital Centre (KMHC) wishes to remind community members who do not have a Family Doctor to visit an inperson information kiosk taking place **this Wednesday**, 28 Enníska/February from 11am to 3pm in the lobby of the Caisse Populaire Kahnawà:ke. Registration for a Family Doctor, which only takes a few minutes, can take place right on-site.

Additionally, KMHC staff will be able to assist community members in renewing expired *Régie de l'assurance maladie* (Medicare) cards. These cards are a requirement for registering for a family doctor.

KMHC Executive Director Valerie Diabo, Krissi Delaronde (Assistant Manager of Outpatient Care) and Tasha Kirby (Outpatient Care Administrative Assistant) will be present at the kiosk to assist and answer questions.
