# JOB SUMMARY:

The Kateri Memorial Hospital Centre is seeking to fill nursing positions on an as-needed basis in the Outpatient Clinic, Homecare Department and/or Community Health Unit.

**The Outpatient Department Nurse** functions within the organizational structure of the ambulatory health care services. The staff nurse assumes the responsibility of practice as a professional nurse using the nursing process as a frame of reference and provides nursing interventions and therapeutics.

**The Homecare Nurse** is part of an interdisciplinary and inter-establishment team that plans and delivers care in collaboration with clients and their families. The nurse must do home visits to assess clients' nursing care needs, develop therapeutic nursing plans, integrated service plans and provide evidence based interventions.

The Community Health Nurse is a professional nurse with a focus on the community; he/she works with other community agencies to promote and preserve health and assist in the development and practice of habits conducive to health. Clientele are people in good health and the nurse strives to prevent disease or delay its progress, to reduce the harmful effects of unavoidable disease and to support those facing crisis situations. The nurse provides information and encouragement to individuals, families, special groups and the community in their normal environments of home, school and the workplace. The nurse assumes a primary prevention role in specialized clinics in collaboration with other organizations, both from inside and outside of the community.
